When a disaster strikes like the one in Nepal, who should be responsible for evacuation of Canadians?

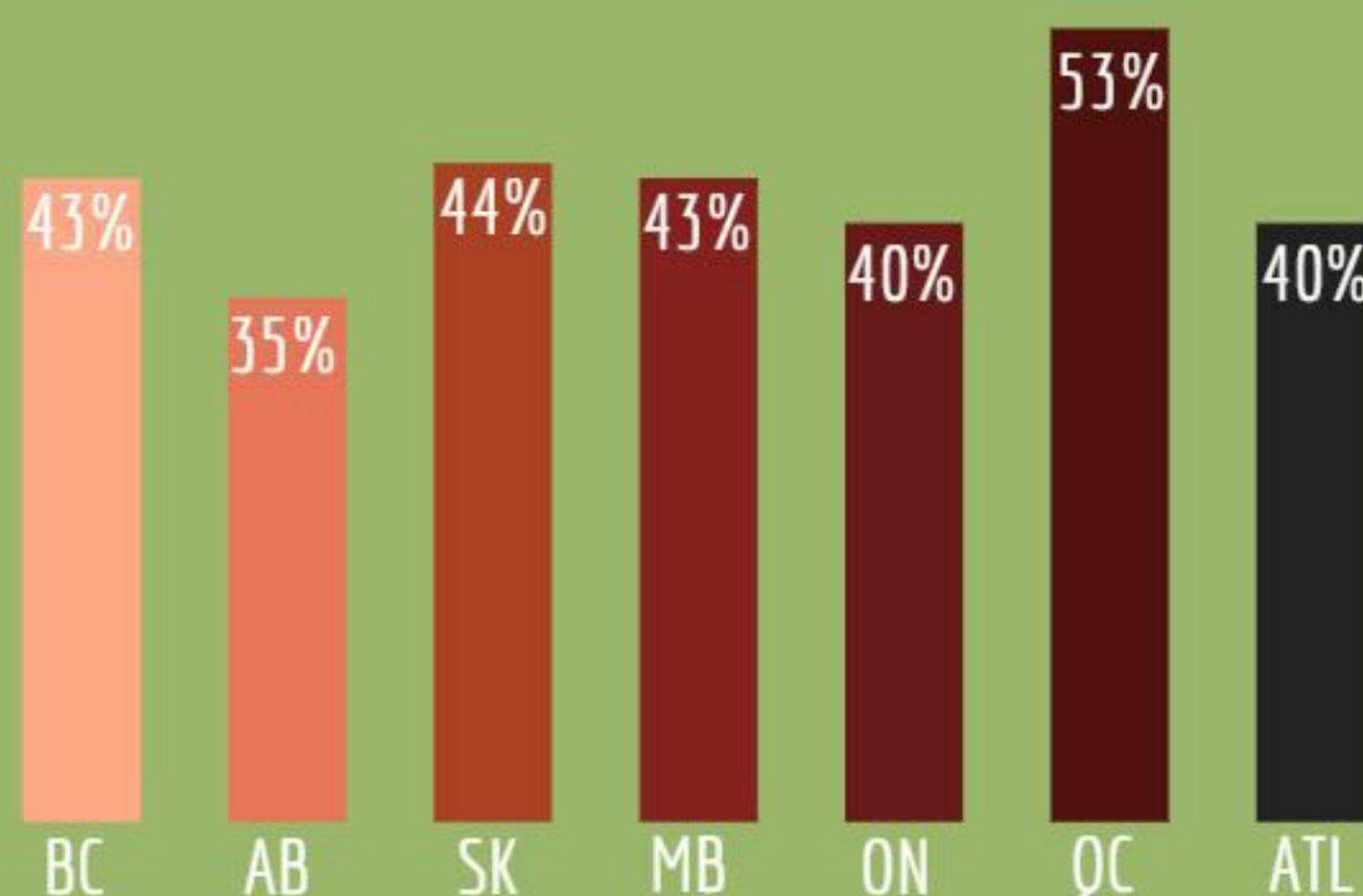
43% of Canadians say the government should be responsible for getting citizens out



71% believe the Canadian govt. response in Nepal has been "about right"

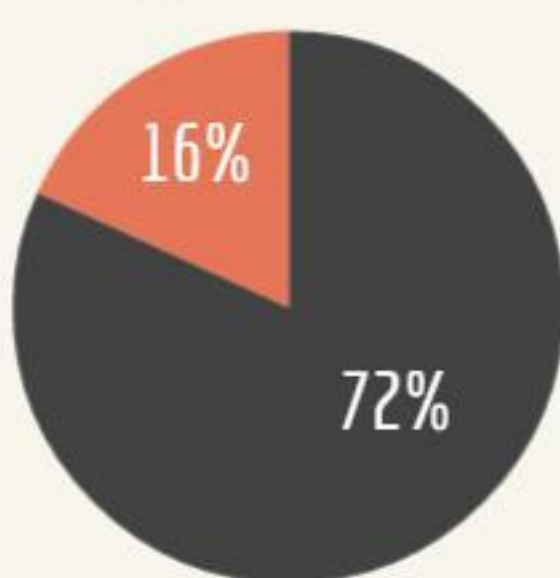


Government should get citizens out - by province

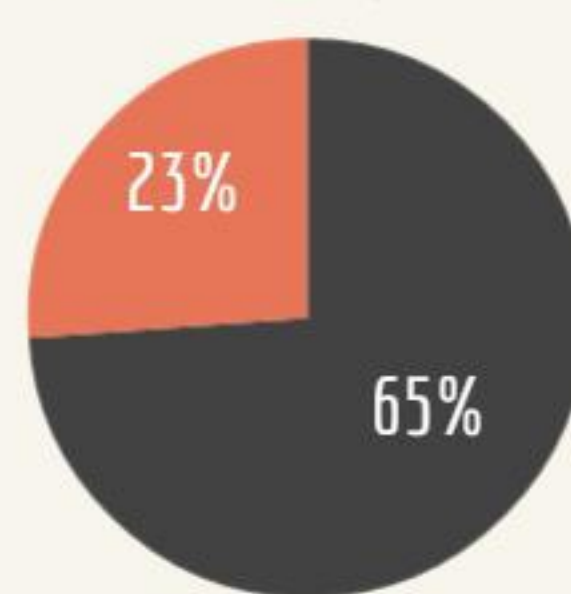


Who should be responsible for getting Canadians out of the country if they traveled to:

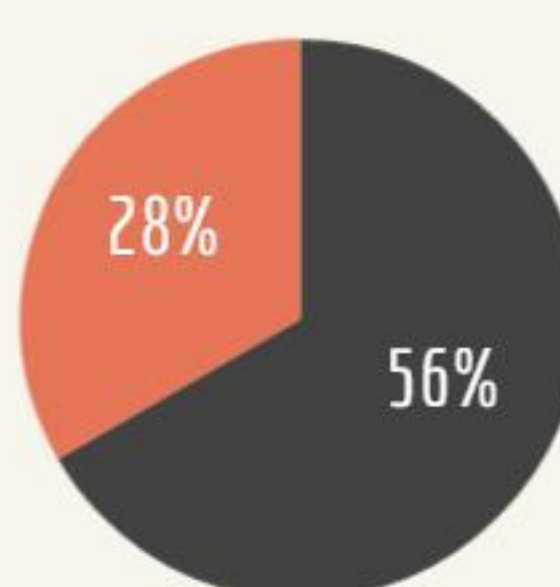
A high risk country



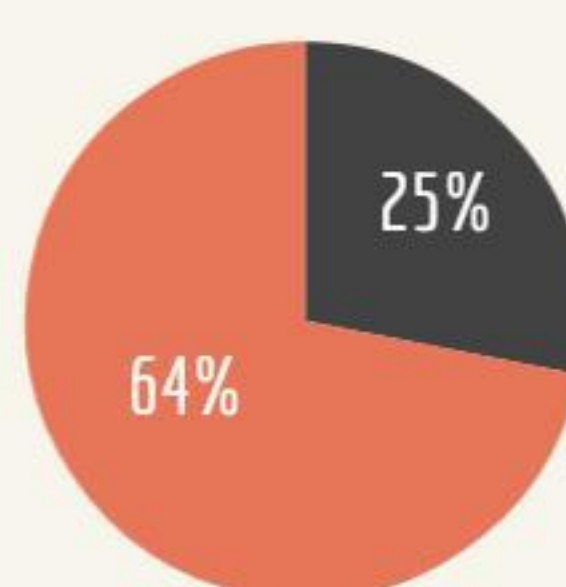
A known conflict zone



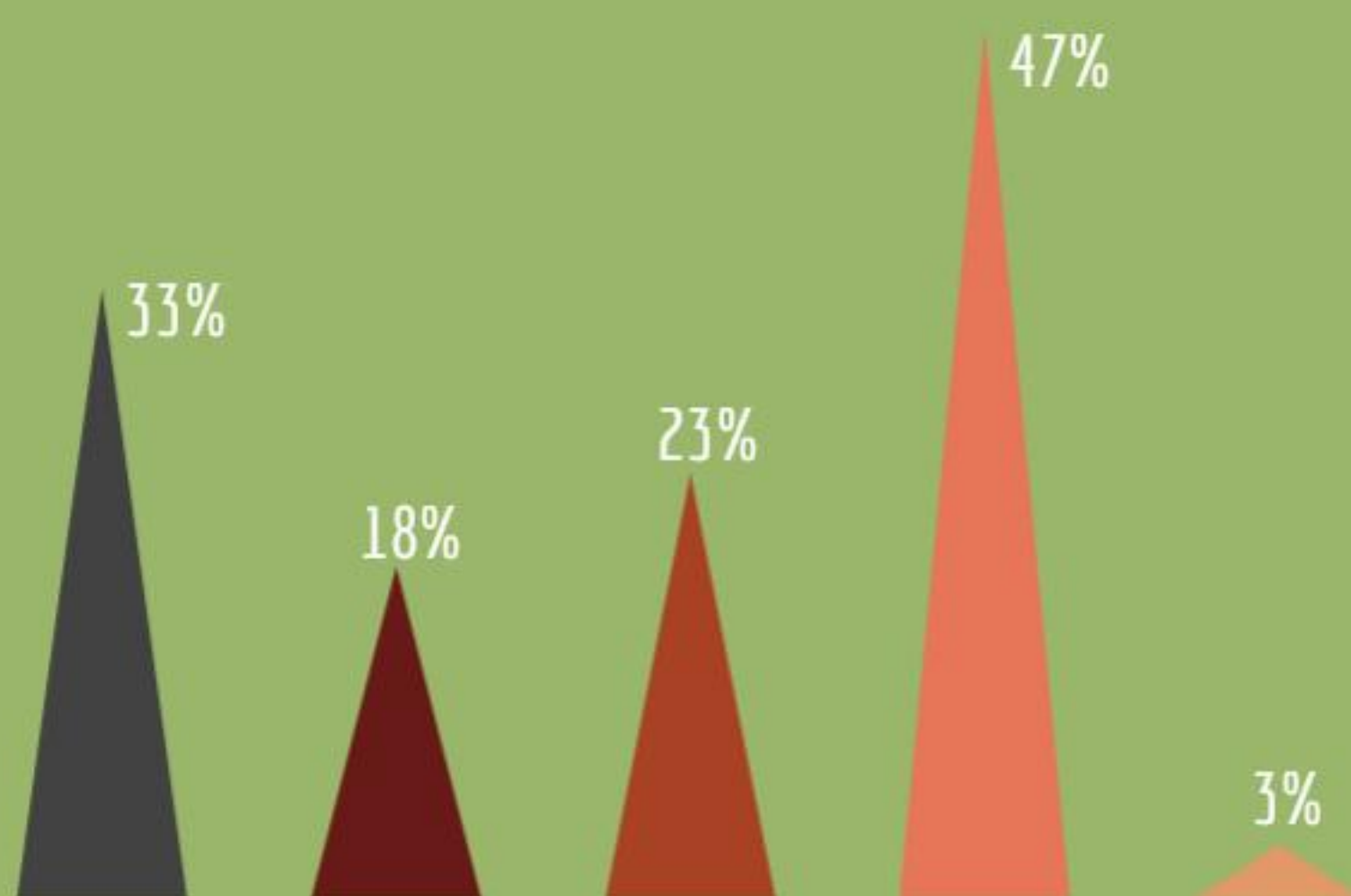
A very remote place
